2. Labor Committee Report

4. Speaker event at Library July 14 (1pm - 5:30pm):

- Sid Smith (GPVA Secretary) agreed to speak -- Received his summary today.
- Tina Rockett (GPVA Chair) also agreed to speak -- CF to confirm & get summary.

- Sean will be reaching out to Howie Hawkins to see if he wants to participate.
- CF sent speaking invitations to a number of progressive UMW student organizations, but nothing definite yet.
- Each speaker must send in a short bio and summary of their speech.
- CF will write FGP introduction.
- Will need a poster, flyers, and promo volunteers

5. Platform & Promo updates

- CF will update FGP platform
- o Garrett will write up a summary of FGP/GP platform & what we do locally, for use in future outreach, donor solicitation, etc.

6. **Dues Proposal**

- Sean suggests a 2/2/2 plan (\$2 each to local, state and national parties), with amount increasing with income level.
- CF reminds group that we can make a distinction between "Voting Members" and mere "Subscribers".
- General consensus that active Committee members should not have to pay \$\$\$ to be a voting member.
- Sean to put proposal up on Google Docs for people to edit & consense on proposal wording, with discussion to be held on fgp-chat mailing list.

7. Candidate for City Council: Christian Zammas (Katora Coffee owner)

o Dropped plan to endorse, however we will still be helping with campaign.

8. Anti-Iran-War Protests

- Proposed that we start a protest outside the home of a local U.S. representative, & call for congress to reclaim its powers under the War Powers Act.
- Discussion about working with other groups (e.g. Dems), but concerns that we would get lost in the mix.
- Sean will see if the GPUS Peace Action Committee is planning anything.

9. Pro-Choice Protests

- Proposed that we protest to prevent anti-choice bills from coming before VA state legislature.
- Concerns that it may be too early for this, and that we are already swamped with actions.

10. FGP Officer Elections (July meeting)

- o Bylaws contains description of the main offices, but we also have committee chairs.
- o Sean & CF to post complete list of offices to be voted on, with descriptions.
- Members encouraged to nominate themselves for offices, by email to chair@fgp.vagreenparty.org .

11. Caroline County Bus Service

- Residents want our help with petitioning & submission to transit board.
- Concerns that we need to show it will be financially viable, and/or show how to pay for it.
- Statistics: ~17,000 riders per year in Caroline?
