1. Food Program

- Voted to make this a new FGP committee, with its own meeting schedule. Sean will chair this committee until upcoming FGP officer elections (July).
- Need to go back to churches to promote.
- Meet up at local farmer's markets early (7am) Saturdays to solicit food donations.

- 3. **Spotsy Solar Power**: Board vote was yes!

- 5. Speaker event at Library July 14 (1pm 5:30pm):
 - o Format: Alternating reception, then speaker, etc., as time permits.
 - Sid Smith (GPVA Secretary) agreed to speak.
 - CF sent speaking invitations to a number of progressive UMW student organizations; heard back from one but nothing definite yet.
 - Each speaker must send in a short bio and summary of their speech.
 - CF will write FGP introduction.
 - Need all (>=2) speakers confirmed & vetted by next FGP meeting, or we cancel.

6. Platform & Promo updates

12. New Proposals

- o Earth Day flyer distribution at Old Mill Park, Sat. 4/27 11am.
- F'burg or Spotsy resolution to ban use of neonicotinoids & sulfoxaflor, to reduce toxins in bee populations.
- o FGP Labor Committee -- Approved, with Sean as chair until officer elections held in July.
